HOLIDAYS & TRANSFER OF AVAILABILITY

Christmas Day (Thursday, December 25, 2014) and New Year's Day (Thursday, January 1, 2015) are statutory holidays for teachers. Aside from that, there are no winter holidays; regular-sector teachers remain available to the college.

If you are away marking and preparing during the inter-semester period you should be reachable by e-mail and/or telephone. If your plans include travelling far enough that you will not be available to the college, make sure to submit a *Transfer of Availability* request to your Sector Dean.

Continuing Education teachers do not have to be available to the college outside of their hours of teaching, the only hours for which they are paid.

ALL TEACHERS: ONE DEADLINE FOR GRADE SUBMISSION

There is **one contractual deadline** for the Fall 2014 submission of grades whether you are a Regular-sector or Continuing Education teacher, whether you have a final exam or not.

The college often cites two different deadlines, but remember the only official deadline is **December 29, 2014**.
